ISB is one of the premier institutions in the world, aiming to provide high quality rounded education to the children, elementary school through high school. This focus on rounded education in a multicultural environment is the primary building block and core value that I significantly appreciate and deeply relate to when I think of ISB.

I was raised in India and moved to the U.S. for my graduate studies. After graduation, I had the opportunity to work for some of the leading multi-national corporations in the world. This gave me the opportunity to live in different countries and travel extensively (both for work and pleasure). One thing that I have learnt through my experience is that today's world is a global village. We are more connected than ever before and a good understanding of the inherent diversity and its appreciation is critical to succeed in life (not just professionally but holistically). Diversity could be cultural, behavioral, gender, or political. Once we learn how to include various diverse components effectively and positively, we can learn how to leverage them for the benefit of ourselves and the society.

One of the primary reasons, why I want to join the Board of Trustees at ISB is because I see the Board playing a significant role in helping drive vision for a holistic and well-rounded development of our children in the future. I see myself providing an additional diverse component to the Board (gender, cultural, and professional) that can help the Board achieve its vision successfully.

One of the critical functions that I see the Board performing is ensuring effective governance of ISB. Some aspects include:

- Ensuring effective governance and oversight on matters associated with corporate and regulatory compliance, as applicable
- Pursuing advocacy and ensuring that interests and impacts are effectively raised, communicated and discussed as appropriate (organizations involved in listed in prior sections)
- Community awareness and sensitivity (various efforts highlighted in prior sections)
- Ability to mentor and guide people, both within the organizations and outside the organization
- Technical/functional strength in the area of economics and finance

As we move forward, I see ISB continuing on its journey to be a premier educational institution in the world. I see ISB working towards developing well-rounded and balanced students that are not just academically qualified to enter into leading universities in the world, but also personalities that are well attuned to global diversity and its complexities.
