

# **SAT / ACT Preparation**

At ISB many of our students take the SAT or ACT tests during their Junior or Senior year to support their university application where needed. This is a part of their application process and goes hand-in-hand with their choice of courses, academic transcript, letters of recommendation and associated application essays. To support ISB students in their quest to obtain the best results in these exams we have researched the range of options available.

All students take the PSAT (Practice SAT test) during their Junior year. On the bottom of each student's PSAT answer sheet is a code for My College Quick Start where students can:

- See their scores and their project SAT score
- Review questions they got wrong and why
- Practice SAT with hundreds of practice questions

All students in ISB High School use the Naviance program to track their university applications and this database now includes a recently purchased new module to assist students to practice SAT/ACT style questions. The module is called PrepMe<sup>™</sup> and can be accessed free of charge through your Naviance login.
