Grade 6 raises money to help provide the materials necessary for the doctors to do the surgeries, and most years we send a group of students to help assist at the site in Mae Sot where the surgeries are performed.

A select group of students will have the opportunity to participate in this mission. They will do this by supporting children and families as they go through the process of preparing for cleft lip/palate surgeries, as well as other surgical procedures. Students who participate in this mission will need to be prepared as this can be a very emotional experience.

If you go, you will need to:

- Help entertain small children while they wait for their surgery. You need to like little kids!
- Assist patients' families with their children.
- Be willing to help in any way you can.
- Interact with lots of people who do not speak English. You do not have to speak Thai to play with little kids.

Students who attend the trip will miss two days of school and will need to make up missed work all missed work soon after they return.

If you are interested in being considered for the trip, we need you to do three things by Tuesday, 1 October 2013.

- 1. Have your parents sign the permission to apply for the trip -form attached
- 2. Have your teachers sign the permission for you to miss two days of school -form attached
- 3. Write/Type a brief essay explaining why you would like to participate in the mission. This is an important part of your application as we will be using your essay to help select who will attend the trip.
