I have also had the privilege to serve on the Board of Trustees during the last year of our previous time in Thailand before we relocated to Tokyo six years ago. Having seen ISB with the eyes of both a parent and Board member and also having had experience with a very different, smaller international school in Japan I believe that I bring to the role of BOT member deep experience and insight into the academic, social and cultural education of our international student population as well as a good feel for the elements that make an international school great. For the past 14 years, my six children have attended 4 different international schools in Nepal, Ethiopia, and Thailand. Although not every aspect these schools has been positive, I have come to believe firmly in the value of an international school education. In fact, it is for that reason that my wife and I decided to bring our family to Bangkok. We chose ISB as the right school for our youngest children over several other possibilities in different countries. We believe in and are committed to the kind of education philosophy ISB espouses. We have been very happy with the school, but we also believe that ISB can be even better.

Since January, I have had the privilege of serving on the Board as an appointed member, and I feel I have been able to bring fresh perspectives to Board discussions. In order to improve ISB further, the Board must play a key role as not just an oversight body but also a real partner of the school Administration, providing different viewpoints and ideas. I would like to continue serving on the Board to contribute to that joint effort.

If elected, I would like to focus on two broad issues, which I believe will make ISB a truly premier international school in 10 years' time. First, as a school that supports and raises 'global citizens', I think ISB should strengthen its language programs, including both mother tongue education and foreign language offerings. Being able to function in mother tongue and expanding the knowledge of different languages are critical for 'global citizens' that we want our children to be. Second, I believe there is considerable scope for improving the 'implementation' of the curriculum. It is of course important to get the design of the education program right, but careful, and often tedious, work on teaching on a daily basis is what gives students a good education. When that fails, even in small ways, students suffer. There is a scope for improvement in this aspect. I would like ISB to be known more for the impeccable implementation of its program that gives every child the best education he or she can get, than for its cutting-edge program design.

Having worked in an international organization for over 30 years, I have developed a real appreciation of the value of diversity. It is not something we tolerate, but rather a source of different perspectives and ideas that can lead us to a better understanding of the problem and innovative solutions. I hope to bring that attitude to the Board, and more broadly to help ISB strengthen its ability to benefit from diversity. For the last 10 years of my career at the World Bank, my responsibility was to set the strategic direction for its large assistance programs in the specific countries I was posted in. I hope to bring the skills I had acquired in those jobs to the Board's discussion on ISB's strategic choices for the future.


