

DONATION BOX: SAVE THE ROHINGYA

Winter has arrived at Ukhia, Bangladesh, and more than 600,000 Rohingya refugees who crossed over from Myanmar since August this year are in need of winter clothes, shoes, hygiene products and living structures.

With support and formal guidance from the embassy of Bangladesh in Thailand, the high school "Students Not Brides (SNB)" is now accepting donations for the Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh.

1500 baht can buy 3 meals for one person for a month

300 baht can buy a set of winter clothes

100 baht can buy a blanket

3000 baht can build a hut for a family of four!

HOW TO DONATE:

You may donate cash only at several donation boxes set up all throughout the school. SNB is not able to accept any other forms of donations due to inability to transport goods to remote location of the refugee camp. Donations can be made in any currency and in any amount. All donations will be deposited into the account of the "Mayor's office in Cox's Bazar in Chittagong, Bangladesh" (one of three primary officially recognized organizations) .

Donation boxes will be available at:

- The High School office (near Khun Gade's desk) during school hours until December 15
- At drop off and pick up by the panther from December 11 through 15
- Come for a Henna design at Secret Garden on December 9!
