Campus access

In order to access campus, all students must adhere to the following:

- [ATK Testing](#) on Sundays (between 4:00pm and 8:00pm) and Wednesdays (between 4:00pm and 8:00pm)
- [The ATK Form](#) must be submitted with ATK testing results on Sundays and Wednesdays (between 4:00pm and 8:00pm)
- ID Cards for entering campus. Students will only be able to access campus if ATK testing has been submitted as per the timelines above
- Masks must be worn at all times - see our [Mask Policy](#)
- Parent access remains strictly by appointment only

Essentials to bring to School every day - a reminder

- Masks - bring more than one surgical or cloth mask. No foam masks or masks with valves
- ID Card
- Water Bottle
- Usual school materials including a charged iPad / laptop



Arrival and Departure

- Arrival / Departure Times:
Elementary School will start at 7:35am and Dismissal begins at 2:15pm
Middle School will start at 7:20am and Dismissal begins at 2:25pm
High School will start at 7:50am (7:20am for HL classes) and Dismissal begins at 2:40pm
- No student should arrive on campus before 7:00am
- Student pick up after school - students will be alphabetical by surname in front of school

Parents are kindly asked to maintain a timely flow of drop off and pick up to avoid crowding at entry and exit points

Food Service

Counter service has resumed with careful management of numbers entering the cafeterias. There will be staggered release times for lunch in MS and HS to ensure greater distancing

Extra seating for MS and HS has been prepared with plexiglass dividers

The refurbished ES Cafeteria has doubled capacity and air filtration systems have been installed

Lunches and snacks will be available through the main cafeteria lines, but all Grind locations will be closed to students

To purchase food students must use their student ID campus cards. Please ensure students have sufficient funds on the campus cards (MS and HS)

Transportation

- Montri will continue to check student temperatures before boarding the bus
- Mask wearing and physical distancing rules apply to all bus riders
- A Montri Bus card is required to board the buses/vans
- Regular buses keep the same configuration of cohort by bus route, as current procedure
- Montri will keep a record of bus riders for each trip for contact tracing purposes
- Activities buses
 - ES mixed grades at 3:45 door to door
 - MS/HS is at 3:45/5:10 at the top soi location (No cohort, all contact tracing)

Contact Tracing

- Keep track of contacts and exposures outside of school in case contact tracing is required
- Limit family exposure and contacts as much as possible to minimize risk of infection

Definitions of Cohorts

- Elementary School students will be in Grade Level Cohorts
- Grade 6 in a Grade Level Cohort
- Grade 7 and Grade 8 as a Cohort
- Grade 9 and Grade 10 as a Cohort
- Grade 11 and Grade 12 as a Cohort

* Some exceptions in MS and HS based on subject choices.

Conditions for Closing a Class, Grade Level, Cohort, Division or the Whole School	
Grade Level	Criteria
PREK 1&2 Grades KG - 5	<p>If there is a positive student case, the individual classroom will close for an initial 3 days and return to Virtual School</p> <p>If PCR test is positive, the individual classroom closes and remains in Virtual School for 14 days</p> <p>If there are 2 positive student cases in a 10 day period in cohort, The COVID Crisis team will meet to review the contact tracing and determine what cohorts/classes would need to return to Virtual School</p> <p>If there are 4 positive cases in a 10 day period, the whole division closes and returns to Virtual School</p> <p>If 10% of the division are seen as high risk close contacts, the whole division closes and returns to Virtual School</p>
Grades 6 - 12	<p>If there is a positive student case, the student remains at home and undergoes a PCR test. Close contact tracing occurs</p> <p>If there are 2 positive student cases in a 10 day period in cohort, The COVID Crisis team will meet to review the contact tracing and determine what cohorts/classes would return to Virtual School</p> <p>If there are 4 positive cases in 10 day period, the whole division (MS or HS) closes and returns to Virtual School</p> <p>If 10% of the division are seen as high risk close contacts, the whole division closes and returns to Virtual School</p>

For any reported positive case, contact tracing will occur to determine if any other members of the community are close contacts according to the Close Contact definition outlined in the reopening plan. The Head of School (or designee) may make the decision to close campus immediately should external or internal conditions make this necessary. The Board of Trustees will then make any subsequent decision to reopen campus.
